- Prior experience in an academic role and a proven record of accredited research publications
- Expertise and teaching experience in the areas of Business Analysis/Systems Analysis and/or Systems Development Projects and/or Information Security

Minimum requirements for Associate Professor level:

- PhD in Information Systems (or related discipline)
- Prior experience in an academic role and a proven record of high quality, high impact accredited research publications
- Expertise and teaching experience in the areas of Business Analysis/Systems Analysis and/or Systems Development Projects and/or Information Security

Practical work experience in an Information Systems/Information Technology role will be an advantage.

Responsibilities:

- Lecture on Information Systems courses at undergraduate and postgraduate level
- Supervise postgraduate students on research projects (e.g. Honours, Masters, PhD etc)
- Conduct academic research in Information Systems on problems relevant to the local South African and broader African context
- Disseminate knowledge through publication of research in various outlets (e.g., journal articles, full paper peer-reviewed conference papers, peer-reviewed books and book chapters, etc.)
