Requirements for the position:

- A relevant tertiary qualification at NQF7 level and at least 2 years' software development experience in a
 corporate/institutional environment; OR a relevant tertiary qualification at NQF6 level and 3 years' software
 development or support experience in a corporate/institutional environment with at least 2 years' experience
 in the software development environment.
- Proven experience and skills in programming and application scripting.
- Demonstrable competence in web design.
- Demonstrable skills in business or systems analysis.
- Proven working knowledge and understanding of the following:
 - C#
 - Scripting language (PHP, HTML, ASP, JavaScript) Latest versions.
 - Databases (SQL 2017/2019 and MySQL)
 - Development Packages (Visual Studio.NET 2019)
 - Microsoft servers, with the focus on IIS, SQL and MySQL Databases and other Microsoft products
