



SENIOR LECTURER: EMERGENCY MEDICINE

The Division of Emergency Medicine seeks to appoint a Senior Lecturer to co-ordinate and convene the PhD Emergency Medicine Programme. This is a full-time permanent position. Responsibilities include developing and co-ordinating the PhD programme, co-ordinating and assisting with the administration of the PhD program, mentoring of post-graduate students in the division, assisting the Division to improve research outputs, and clinical Emergency Centre service commitments.

Requirements include:

- Qualification registerable as a medical doctor with the Health Professions Council of South Africa
- Completed or within 6 months of completing PhD **and** minimum 5 years' experience in clinical emergency care
- Excellent interpersonal abilities
- Excellent written and verbal communication
- Demonstrable research expertise

Responsibilities include:

- Developing and coordination of the PhD Emergency Medicine programme including establishing an academic quality assurance programme for monitoring and evaluation
- Liaison with faculty to ensure smooth administration of the PhD programme and appropriate progression of students
- Mentoring (including research supervision and co-supervision) of post-graduate students in the Division of Emergency Medicine
- Assisting the Division to improve Research outputs
- Clinical service commitments as determined by the Head of Division of Emergency Medicine.
