- Lead convene and manage the BaDr course
- Convenor for Year 2 of the MBChB programme
- Overall co-convenor of the Becoming a Doctor (BaDr) course
- Convene and manage the Family Medicine strand of the BaDr course, including staff management
- Provide the designated Family Medicine teaching (including updating and improving the curriculum, learning and assessment activities as well as course evaluations) for the BaDr course
- Oversee, participate in clinical teaching and organize rotations at the designated training sites
- Oversee and supervise the Special Study Module (for MBChB students) for Family Medicine
- Develop and sustain appropriate relationships with all relevant role-players and stakeholders, including relevant personnel at the designated facilities
- Participate in Faculty activities such as staff meetings and staff development activities
- Actively pursue independent research in Family Medicine
- Coordinate and supervise weekly training sessions for Family Medicine interns
- Postgraduate supervision
- Coordinate and manage the annual Divisional GP Refresher Course
