Requirements:

- A track record of teaching either full or part-time
- Proven administrative and organizational skills
- Currently in active clinical practice and able to function at a District Health Level caring for ambulatory patients
- Familiarity with the South African health care system
- The ability to interact effectively with a wide range of professionals at designated teaching sites
