- At least 5 years of teaching experience in health economics within an academic environment
- Experience developing teaching material including case studies
- At least 5 years of research experience with evidence of research outputs
- Experience of working with a team of researchers
- Experience in low-and/or middle-income countries, preferably in South Africa
- Good writing, presentation and conceptual skills

Responsibilities:

- Participation in the teaching of various Postgraduate Diploma and Masters modules – teaching certain sessions; compilation of relevant reading materials; development of case study materials where appropriate; setting and marking certain assignments; and setting, preparing model answers and marking certain examination questions
- Coordination of the Postgraduate Diploma
- Supervision of Masters students
- Active participation in one major research project where s/he will bear the primary responsibility for the literature review, detailed methodological development, and data collection and analysis activities
