- Registration as a Pharmacist with the South African Pharmacy Council

- The Pharmacist is responsible for the co-ordination and handling of all aspects of drug keeping of Investigational Products (IP) for participants enrolled in clinical trials, including but not limited to: ordering, receiving, storing, recording and dispensing of trial medication and vaccine, utilizing Good Pharmacy Practice (GPP), GCP and Good Manufacturing Practice (GMP).
- The pharmacist may be responsible for the counselling of participants regarding trial medication and investigational products and the monitoring of compliance and adherence and any adverse/side effects and will liaise with clinical staff regarding participant care.
