We are seeking a full time Senior Clinical Research Worker within the research domain, supporting studies being conducted within the group which include a Phase III clinical trial to test the efficacy of a novel treatment regimen in TB meningitis (INTENSE-TBM trial). This ongoing clinical trial is currently recruiting from five sites across South Africa. We seek one Senior clinical research worker to join a research team based between the three recruiting clinical sites in Cape Town: New Somerset Hospital, Khayelitsha District Hospital and Mitchell's Plain Hospital; and three hospitals visited for follow-up visits: Brooklyn Chest Hospital, DP Marais Hospital, and Groote Schuur Hospital.

This 12 months full-time contract post will be funded by the Institute of Infectious Disease and Molecular Medicine (IDM) (<http://www.idm.uct.ac.za>) within the Faculty of Health Sciences of the University of Cape Town (UCT). **The daily activities of this post will mainly be based at the named clinical research sites in Cape Town with some activity at UCT offices.**
