- Previous exposure and willingness to be trained in gynaecological examination
- Fluency in English and Xhosa
- Experience in supply chain management

The role includes general study administration, supervision of community health workers, maintaining clinical supplies, participant recruitment, screening, consenting, enrolment and follow-up visits.
