The second post will be filled by someone interested in applying geochemistry to any aspect of solid Earth petrogenesis or crustal processes, and who has practical analytical experience. A suitably qualified candidate, appointed at the professorial level in either post, will be considered for the title of Chamber of Mines Chair in Geochemistry.

Requirements:

- A PhD in an appropriate field at the time of appointment for both posts.
- Experience in the broad fields of economic geology or geochemistry.
- Suitable track record of research and publication.
- For the economic geology position, experience in the mining industry will be an advantage.
- Ability to lead student field excursions (both posts)
- Willingness to teach courses at the introductory level (geochemistry)

For appointment at the Senior Lecturer, Associate Professor or Professor level:

- · Enhanced track record of research, publication and supervision
- Evidence of relevant teaching and mentoring experience.

Responsibilities:

- Establishing an active research programme in economic geology or geochemistry.
- Teaching at undergraduate and postgraduate level including leading appropriate field courses.
- Attracting research funding and students needed to sustain an international-level research programme.
