The successful applicant will be a Fellow of the Actuarial Society of South Africa (or another recognised international actuarial professional body), although applicants close to qualification, who have postgraduate degrees, will also be considered.

The appointee must have an interest in undertaking research and will be expected to supervise Honours and Master's research projects, as appropriate, in their area(s) of expertise.

Our staff are expected to maintain a connection to actuarial work by consulting, and to participate in the activities of the professional body. This connection to the profession is essential for maintaining the relevance of the programme, as well as advancing the discipline of Actuarial Science.

Minimum requirements:

- For appointment at Lecturer level, a qualified or nearly qualified Actuary with an interest in teaching and research.
- For appointment at Senior Lecturer level, a qualified actuary and a Master's degree.

Prior tertiary level teaching experience is advantageous.

The annual remuneration packages, including benefits, at the respective levels are as follows:

- **Lecturer** : R 730 510 (excluding a scarcity allowance)
- **Senior Lecturer** : R 887 294 (excluding a scarcity allowance)

The scarcity allowance for a qualified actuary is 50% and for a nearly qualified actuary is 25%.
